Project Description

The project comprises of construction of a steel structure hanger, sandwich panel cladding and all necessary equipment and instrumentation required for maintenance and repair of heavy equipment, vehicles and machinery.

The 8 meter high Steel structure was imported from England, Cranes from Germany, and the Sandwich panels from Italy. All electrical, lighting, fire alarm, vacuum/ compressed air, lubrication system, and instrumentation equipment was imported from England.

The workshop is equipped with oil dispensers, tire replacement workshop, engine overhaul and repair workshop, and heavy equipment repair, calibration and maintenance facilities.



The workshop also has a lean-to that has space for offices, stores, laboratories, and washrooms. The engine repair workshop is equipped with a 5T overhead crane. The Main workshop is equipped with a 10T overhead crane and the external area is handled by a 2T mobile gantry cranes.
